



The CBT students chose Gros Morne for their first village seminar. Jocelyn Decembre from the 6th Class of the CBT grew up here. It is located in northwest Haiti, where there are few congregations.

Gros Morne was chosen because three denominational religious groups had shown an interest in learning more about following the doctrine of Christ. In addition to the denominational leaders, the congregation and many from the community attended.


The CBT students conducted services on Sunday. During the week, they knocked doors and taught seminars during the day. At night, they held evangelistic meetings. Eighty-four people attended the meetings and seminars.

Two people were baptized during the meetings, and another responded after the students left. One person was restored to the church. There was some opposition, especially from the Adventists. The local church was encouraged and edified.


